## Meet Jacob & Jackson

The Ronald McDonald House was our home away from home for 24 days while our identical twin boys were in the NICU. Jacob and Jackson were born 7 weeks premature and needed to learn how to eat and regulate their temperature. Living 1.5 hours away from Janet Weis Children's hospital in Danville was going to make it impossible to see and spend time with our tiny babies during this precious time. After I was discharged from the hospital, a nurse informed us about the Ronald McDonald House and told us to call to see if they had a room for us. We called that day and to our delight they had room! We were able to stay at the Ronald McDonald House for 24 days. **This allowed us to visit the NICU everyday for hours to bond with our babies.** This was especially important to our family as we had given birth to a 34-week baby girl just 314 days prior and lost her to stillbirth. We are so grateful the Ronald McDonald House was able to provide us a room to stay in during our boys NICU stay.
