I was transferred to Danville at 33 weeks pregnant with pre-eclampsia. My condition was getting worse and my son's heart rate was dropping. I had an emergency c-section at 33 weeks and 5 days. My son was taken to the NICU. When I was getting discharged, the wonderful nursing staff talked to me and my fiancé about the Ronald McDonald House if we would be interested in staying there. We agreed and they began working on setting us up with a room. After my discharge we went to see the staff at the Ronald McDonald House. They were friendly and very helpful, showed us to our room and we had a tour. My son was in the NICU for 14 days. *We are forever grateful for the generosity of the caring nurses and the staff at the Ronald McDonald House.* Dinner was provided by local churches and sorority groups for all the families staying in the House! We had a clean comfortable room. They have a fridge for everyone to use, which is very helpful due to the fact I was pumping and needed some place to store my breast milk for the night. The staff helped us after we were getting packed to leave the day my son was discharged. We felt

truly blessed by everyone. My son is now 3 months old and doing well! I can't thank everyone enough for everything they've done for us!
